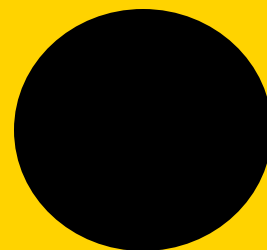
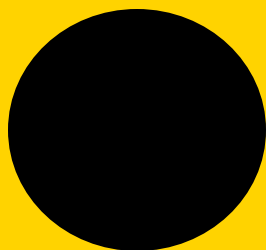
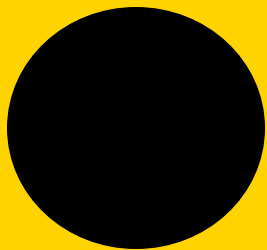
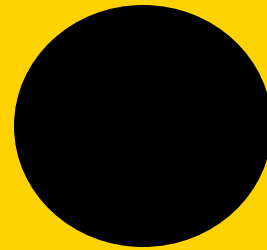
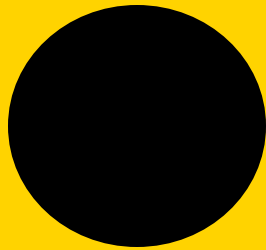
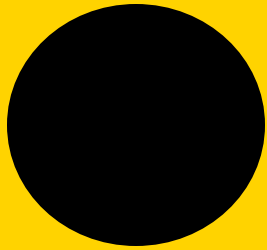
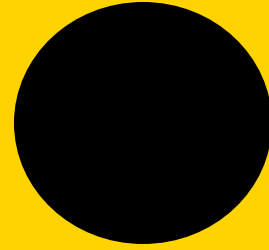
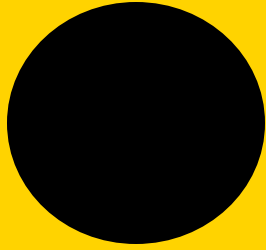
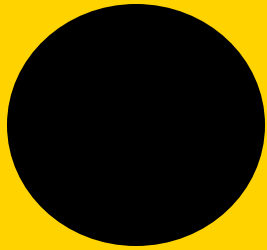
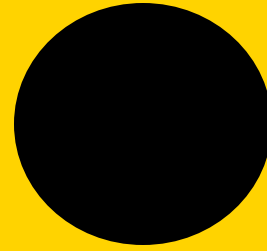
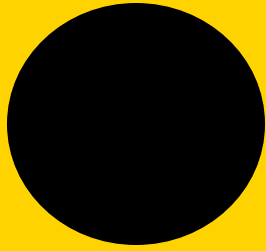
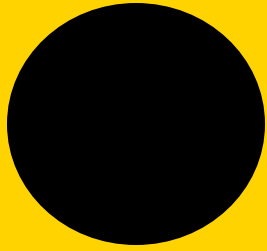
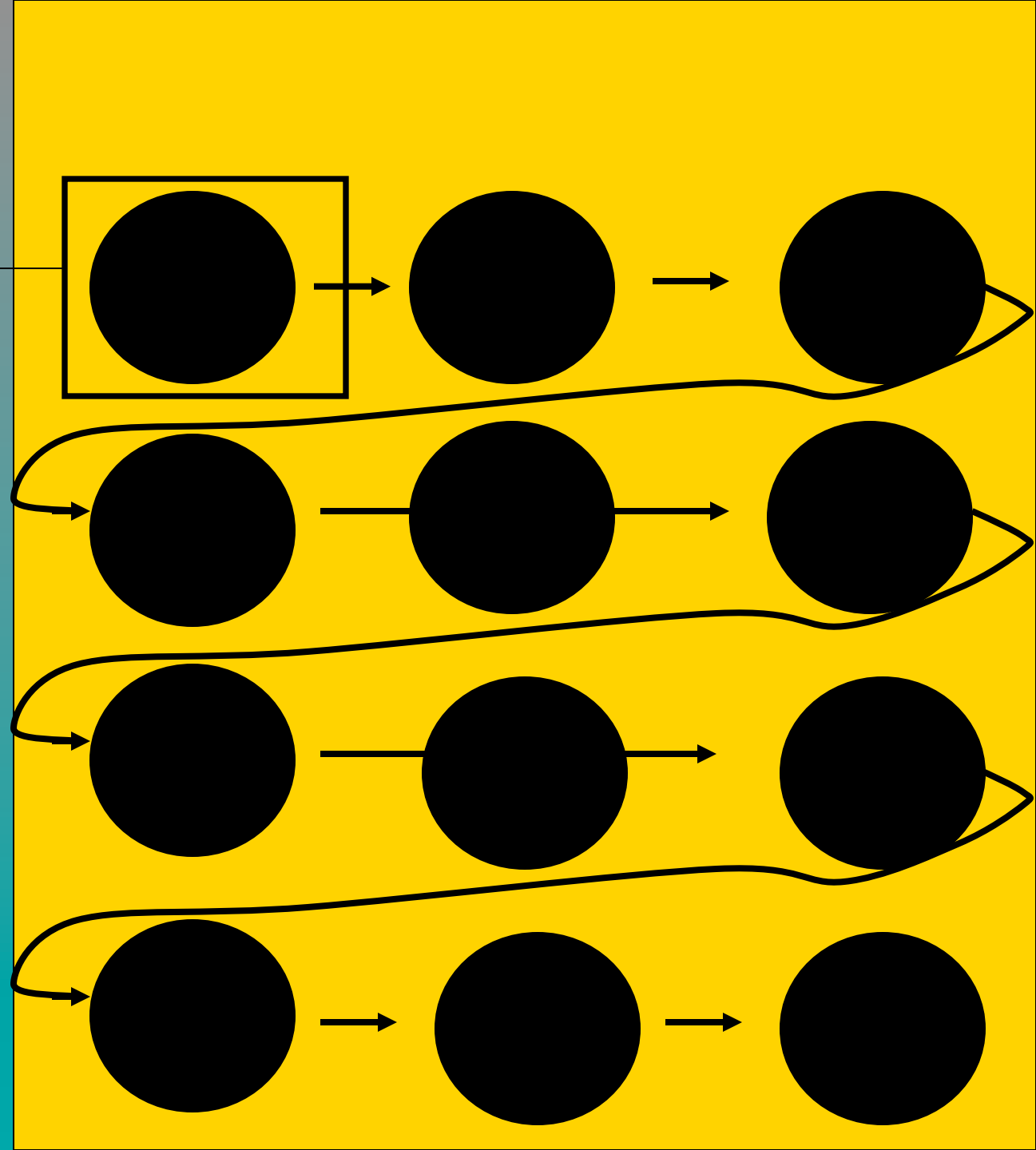


How to Score a Target

Step 1:

target.



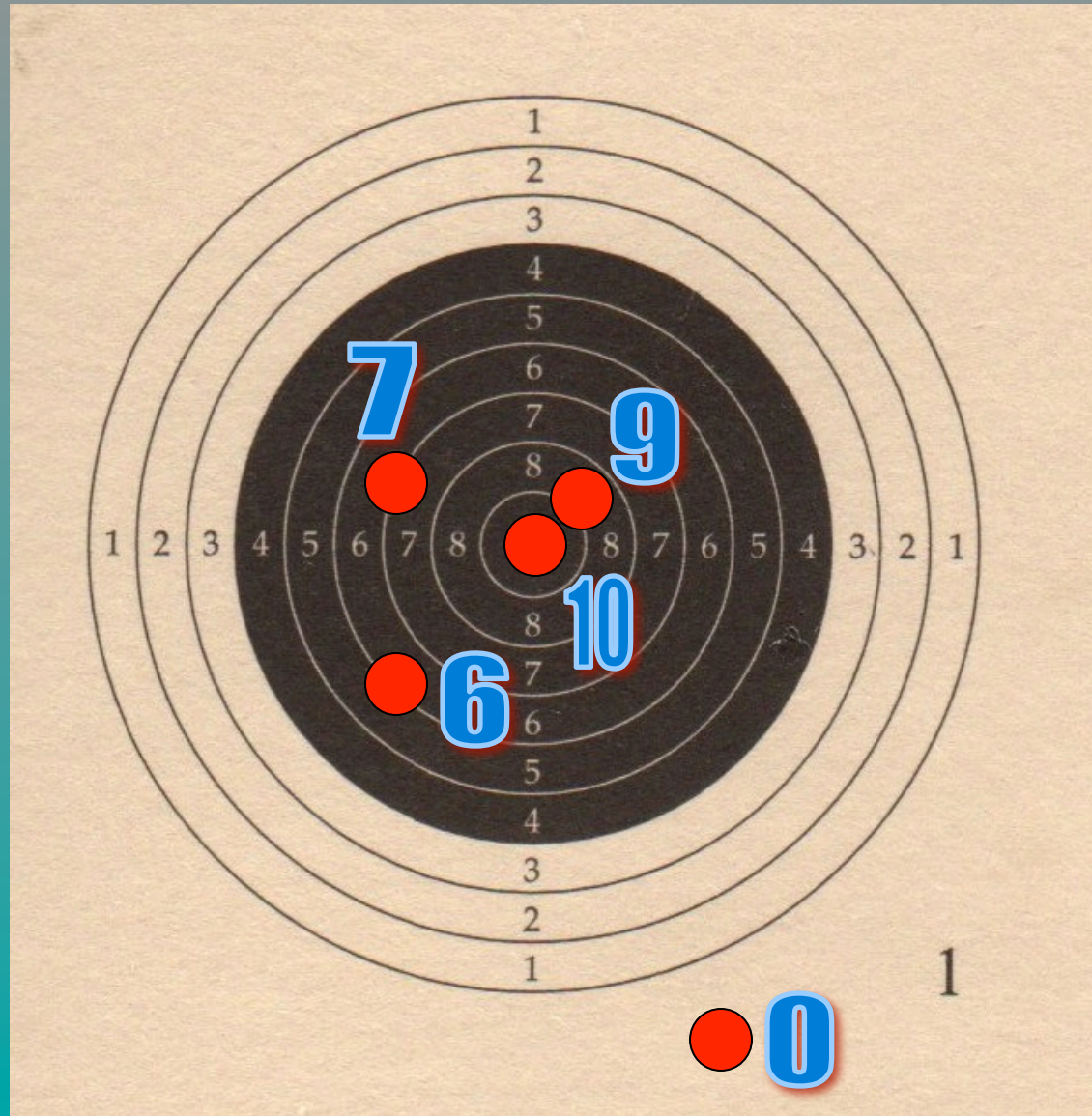
Step 2:

Step 3:

The scores are right on the target. If the pellet breaks the most inner line it is a 9. If the pellet blocks the white dot it is a 10. If the pellet brakes the line it is the higher score.

-If you see a lead print (or a distinct circle) but the paper is ripped you score the print.



Step 4:

Add up all the scores and circle the total.

Step 5:

Put the target in the shooters book.
